What part of the orphan crisis speaks to your heart the most?

Here are some areas to pray about and reflect upon:

orphan prevention • medical care • missions • fostering or adoption

meeting basic needs • advocacy for human rights • first family/biological family care

Ask Jesus to break your heart for what breaks His, and then boldly be His hands and feet there.
